MRM Clinical Translation Committee - Terms of reference

Mandate

This committee is responsible for identifying clinical research opportunities related to regenerative medicine currently happening or in development at McGill University and affiliated hospitals. It will support researchers in structuring future clinical research projects and to help build compliance with regulatory agencies. This committee is mainly composed of MRM clinical researchers. This clinical pipeline will promote translational research involving stem cells and/or regenerative medicine. This committee could also help set up monthly clinical seminars and clinics.

Specific areas of responsibility

- Identify and track clinical research related to regenerative medicine currently happening at McGill
- Support and advise MRM researchers willing to move their research towards clinical application

Composition

The MRM Clinical Translation Committee is composed of faculty members, clinical researchers working in McGill-affiliated hospitals, drawn from membership of the Network. Each member is nominated for a 2-year term, renewable.

Recurrence of meetings

The MRM Clinical Translation Committee does not hold regular meetings but can be called upon to meet if needed.
