Mandate

The role of this committee includes organization of the [MRM Annual Symposium](#), the [MRM Talks](#) webinar series and seminars related to the field of regenerative medicine, as well as the development of training workshops.

Specific areas of responsibility

- Planning, organizing and raising funds for the MRM Annual Symposium
- Planning and organizing the MRM Talks
- Developing training workshops in collaboration with the MRM Education Committee
- Collaborating with McGill Departments to host seminar speakers of common interest

Composition

The MRM Scientific Programming Committee is composed of faculty and trainee members, drawn from membership of the Network. Each member is nominated for a 2-year term, renewable.

Recurrence of meetings

The MRM Scientific Programming Committee holds between 5 and 8 meetings/year.
